Garden State Historic Preservation Trust Fund

Take notice that in compliance with the New Jersey Garden State Preservation Trust Act, the New Jersey Historic Trust anticipates the following availability of funds.

Grant Name: Garden State Historic Preservation Trust Fund Grant Round 2010 Historic Site Management Grants and Capital Preservation Grants Level I and II.

Amount of Money in the Grant Program: In the 2010 grant round, approximately \$10.2 million in matching grants will be available for both historic site management grants and capital preservation grants. Funding for the grants is dedicated from the Garden State Preservation Trust Fund, which voters approved in November 2009.

Eligible applicants are agencies or entities of State government, agencies or entities of county government, agencies or entities of municipal government, and nonprofit organizations organized under the New Jersey Nonprofit Corporation Act (N.J.S.A. 15A:101 et seq.) that qualify for tax-exempt status under Section 501© of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S. 501(c)).

Eligible Properties must be listed in, or eligible to be listed in, the New Jersey Register of Historic Places and/or the National Register of Historic Places per N.J.A.C. 7:4. In addition, there are other eligibility requirements concerning ownership and leases, which vary according to the type of grant requested.
