#### FALL HEALTH OBSERVANCES INCLUDE NUTRITION AND CANCER

National Food Safety Education Month, National 5-A-Day Week, and National Cholesterol Education Month are among the many health observations scheduled in the fall of each year. These health themes can be incorporated into classes or programs using the following audiovisuals.

In *The Food Groupie Adventures*, the food groupies come to life to help youngsters learn to eat from all the food groups. For each group, the variety of foods in the group and the functions of that group are highlighted. A storybook about the food groupies and an action figure for each food group are available.

Intended for children in PreK - Grade 1.

**Your Nutrition Style:** New Dietary Guidelines provides a very thorough presentation including the Food Guide Pyramid, serving sizes, body composition and exercise. Produced in 2002 by Learning Seed, this video provides an excellent overview of the subject. A viewer's guide provides a summary of the information covered.

**To Your Health! Food Safety for Seniors** emphasizes that "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure." After explaining why seniors are especially susceptible to foodborne illnesses and why these illnesses are a growing problem, the video gives specific, practical tips for safe eating both at home and when eating out.

Specifically targeted to senior adult audiences.

*October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month.* Even young women can learn the importance of early detection in successfully treating breast cancer. The 1997 video, *Instructions for Breast Self-Examination*, provides a complete description of the procedure. It also discusses mammography and clinical examination. Produced by the American Cancer Society.
