- Resolution 20-01 all 70 districts have been listed. A motion was made by Commissioner Schuster and seconded by Commissioner Nall to approve Resolution 20-01.
- 3. Revaluation Orders: Bogota and New Milford Patrick Wilkins addressed the Board for Bogota. Would like the order be made for completion for 2022. New council members have just come on and maps need to be updated. There is a new engineer in town as well. Also there are no state tax appeals. The ratio is 80%. A motion was

made by Commissioner Schuster, seconded by Commissioner O'Shea to grant the dates requested. Commissioner Eilert recused. Assessor Wilkins also makes the same request for New Milford which was also approved. Commissioner O'Connor recused on New Milford.

- 4. Revaluation orders were approved by the Director for Maywood, Oakland, Ridgefield, River Edge, Rochelle Park and Wallington. Letters will be sent out to the municipal clerks advising that the Director has approved the orders.
