*Remembering Our Fallen* is a traveling photographic war memorial (now two identical versions) that honors our post-9/11 military Fallen. This memorial, with 33 Tribute Towers, also includes our military who served in combat zones post-9/11, but succumbed to the invisible wounds suffered.

### TRIBUTE TOWERS

The Tribute Towers are designed to travel and were unveiled at the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in 2017. Unlike brick and mortar memorials, this exhibit is designed to travel and includes both military and personal photos. Its legacy will be that these men and women are remembered and their names will be spoken, while helping to lessen the grief of their families. A Tower has been added to include our military who dies stateside or in non-combat training exercises.

### PATRIOTIC PRODUCTIONS

Patriotic Productions is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to honor our military service-members, past and present. Our focus is on preserving cherished memories and recording stories for future generations of those who died fighting for America. We do that by creating traveling photo exhibits and holding events open to veterans, their families, and the public.
