# ~ <u>ZOO TO YOU</u> ~

Zoo to You is a new and innovative way to bring the educational programs of the Bergen County Zoo right to your computer screen. Although we know nothing can replace the experience of traveling to the Zoo and seeing the animals and staff in person, this is the closest you can get to the zoo experience without needing busses and permission slips. These programs are being offered for \$50.00 per class.

Each program is 30-45 minutes long, for up to 50 participants, and include at least one live animal demonstration. Programs are through the Cisco Webex Meetings.

# ~ <u>Programs</u>~

### **Animal Tales:**

You and your group will listen to a story from one of our favorite authors. Then we will have several activities for students to follow along with our educator, including a live animal demonstration. Books include but are not limited to: <u>Is Your Buffalo Ready for Kindergarten</u> by Audrey Vernick (Preschool/Kindergarten) <u>What Pet to Get</u> by Emma Dobb (Kindergarten to Second Grade) <u>Annie and the Wild Animals</u> by Jan Brett (First and Second Grades) <u>Is a Camel a Mammal ?</u> by Tish Rabe (First and Second Grades).

# Wild Pets:

Learn the difference between wild, farm and pet animals. Then put that knowledge to use as we play "Wild - Farm - Pets". Includes 2 live animal demonstrations. 30-45 minutes, First to Third Grades.

# **<u>Reptile Freestyle:</u>**

Learn what makes a reptile a reptile and some of the many adaptations they have which help them to survive and move in their specific habitats. 45+ minutes, Third to Fifth Grades.

# Animal Adaptations:

Discuss Natural Selection, Selective Breeding, and Behavioral/Physical Adaptations. This program includes two live animal demonstrations. 45 minutes, Grades 4-12

# **Animal Wrappers:**

Scientists categorize animals by common traits. Become scientists with us as we discuss the differences between vertebrates and invertebrates. Then learn how fur, scales, feathers and skin can be used to help classify vertebrate animals. 30-45 minutes, First to Fourth Grades.

# Habitat Survival:

A brief discussion of Behavioral and Physical Adaptations then we move on to live animal demonstrations. This can be a follow-up to the Animal Adaptations class or stand on its own. The presenter will chose animals to bring to the program to discuss how their specific adaptations would help them in their native habitat. 45 minutes, Grades 4-12

### **Animal Encounter:**

The presenter will choose animals to bring to the virtual class room for your group to meet and discuss. Please include any specific topics or animals you wish to focus on. Exhibit animals are not able to be brought to the class room however, we may include video of specific Bergen County Zoo animals when available. 30—45 minutes, 2nd to 12th grades.

### Zoo Tour:

Come with us on a virtual tour of the Bergen County Zoo. We will show short videos of our zoo animals while the educator narrates for your group. We will have a short question and answer period after each group of animals. 45 minutes, all ages.
