We are pleased to announce that the 45th Annual Bergen County Teen Arts Festival will be held on Friday, May 15, 2020 from 8:30 AM until 3:30 PM at Bergen Community College, 400 Paramus Road, Paramus, N.J. Preparations are well under way and the application process is beginning.

This document contains your General Information and the Preliminary Registration Form (which also serves as an invoice for your school business office). The Final Application Forms for each of the six arts areas will be sent by email to all School Liaisons and will be posted at: https://www.co.bergen.nj.us/cultural-historic-affairs/teen-arts-program (or by googling "Bergen County Teen Arts Festival). Final Applications will be mailed to any school that is unable to access them.

Remember, if just a middle or high school is attending, the fee is \$400. If students from both middle and high schools are attending, the fee is \$800. Of course the \$800 fee means you have double the performance slots and more students will be able to attend the 35+ workshops that are presented each year.

The Preliminary Registration Form should be emailed or mailed back to us as soon as you receive approval from your administration to attend the festival. You do not need to wait for your Purchase Order to be issued to send the Preliminary Registration Form. <u>Please do not forget to order your busses in a timely manner to insure your transportation arrangements for May 15!!!</u>

Please play close attention to the deadlines listed in this packet. These dates have been established to allow for efficient organization and scheduling of our program. The festival will be a more effective celebration of the arts in Bergen County if all schools adhere to the guidelines listed herein.

Please note the following for 2020:

- 1. The Bergen County Teen Arts Festival date frequently coincides with the last day of the Advanced Placement Testing. Our date is controlled by the Bergen Community College calendar. This year the Advanced Placement tests on Friday, May 15, 2020 are Microeconomics, Computer Science A, Latin and, unfortunately, Music Theory. Please plan accordingly.
- 2. Due to the popularity of the festival and the continued increase in requests to perform, some groups last year were asked to perform very early or very late in our day. Large Group Theater performance slots were reduced in time to fit as many groups in as possible. This year, we will be taking steps to give every group adequate and reasonable time slots. Therefore, APPLICATION SUBMISSION DEADLINES WILL BE ADHERED TO MORE STRICTLY. Late applications may not be honored and groups may be turned away.
- 3. With the cooperation of the weather, outdoor performance sites and workshops will return to the festival in 2020.
- 4. The online presence of the festival will continue to expand. Again this year our full program will be available as a mobile-friendly website. Students and teachers will be able to access times and locations of critiques and workshops through their web-enabled devices. Certain additional information on the festival may only be accessed online.
- 5. Small Group Vocal Music and Piano Performance sites will not be combined this year. They will have separate critique sites so more performances will be possible.
- 6. A new "Spotlight Performance" site will be established in the cafeteria. Groups in Dance, Music, and Theater who are participating in the critique process may <u>volunteer</u> for a second public performance in this environment. Watch for more specific information on this new event at the festival later in the year.
- 7. Video and Creative Writing entries will continue to be submitted digitally. Continued refinements in the Creative Writing submission process will be made.
- 8. Allowing all students to attend the workshops that they are interested in continues to be one of our biggest problems. Students frequently are "shut out" of their workshop choices. We will expand the use of entry tickets for many popular workshops. Students who are on line to attend workshops that are typically over-subscribed will be issued tickets by the workshop volunteer. It is hoped that this will prevent students from waiting on line for a workshop only to be denied entry due to space limitations. However we cannot guarantee a place for everyone at all workshops.
- 9. We will continue to renew and refresh our workshop line-up while retaining favorite workshops from the past several years. Over 15 new and exciting workshops have been suggested by our Planning committees. Please watch for our new workshop line-up early next spring.
- 10. We will continue to make our critique process as effective as possible. Recorded critiques, amplified critiques and written critiques will be used appropriately at various sites.
- 11. Upon the recommendation of the Dance Planning Committee, Small Dance groups will now be 7 students or less (instead of 5) and Large Dance groups will be 7 students or more.
- 12. The very successful Art Show will remain in the Art Gallery in West Hall.

- 13. Sponsoring teachers should be careful about the number of students participating in Small Group Performance sites. Sending groups with too many participants to these sites decreases the effectiveness of those critiques and creates an uncomfortable situation for all.
- 14. Each school is required to supply two volunteers to assist at the festival (or pay an "in lieu of" fee). Teachers or parents are acceptable volunteers. As our festival grows, the assistance of volunteers becomes a more important element in the success of our program. Schools are encouraged to send volunteers who are interested in being an active part of the Teen Arts Festival. Volunteers who will not monitor attendance at workshops or assist with student control or assist workshop or critique artists are of limited help. Please inform your volunteers that we need them to be active participants in the festival rather than observers. Several steps will be taken this year to increase communication and supervision of volunteers to make this process more effective.

Please note - all forms, Preliminary, Final or Information – have once again been created with PDF "Text Fields". You may complete the forms by typing directly into them or printing them out and completing them by hand.

General Instructions

Enclosed are General Information and your Preliminary Registration Form & Invoice.

<u>Preliminary Registration Form</u>. Please return to the Teen Arts office by November 15, 2019. This form will advise us that your school intends to participate in the festival and will allow us to determine how many workshops and critiquers will be needed.

<u>Voucher for payment.</u> If you are paying the registration fee by purchase order please send a voucher as soon as possible in the amount of \$400 for us to sign and return to your board office for payment by February 12, 2020.

<u>Insurance Certificates</u> covering your school/students on the festival date in the amount of one million dollars should be in our office by February 12, 2020. The Certificate must show the insured as Bergen Community College, 400 Paramus Road, Paramus, N.J. AND also the Bergen County Department of Parks, Division of Historic & Cultural Affairs, One Bergen County Plaza, 4th Floor, Hackensack, NJ 07601 as additionally insured.

<u>Final Application Forms</u> that tell us what genres your students will be entering, the amount of art you expect to display, and your arrival and departure times on festival day. Final Application Forms will be emailed to all School Liaisons and will be available on our webpage:

This information assists in the creation of effective schedules. Every effort is made to schedule performances during the times YOU indicate on these forms. **DUE BY JANUARY 17, 2020.**

<u>Volunteer names and addresses</u> are very important for a smooth-running festival, and must reach our office no later than **April 10, 2020**. It is imperative that we receive this information early, as the volunteer schedules have to be determined and a letter sent to each volunteer at their homes several weeks prior to the festival date explaining their duties on festival day. Each attending school is required to supply two (2) volunteers to assist us on the festival day. Please be sure that we get the names and addresses on time.

<u>Chaperones.</u> Each attending school will be asked to have at least one chaperone or teacher for every 25 students in attendance at the festival with a minimum of two. This can be teachers, para-professionals, or parents. This number <u>does not</u> include the 2 volunteers that are required to help manage the festival. Names and contact telephone numbers of chaperones will be collected on the day of the festival.

<u>Creative Writing entries</u>: Although the actual entries are not due until **April 10, 2020**, we do need the Final Application Form returned to us so that we may schedule your school for a critique time. This single page should list the total number of submitted work. Please forward the Final Application Form to us by the **January 17, 2020** deadline date.

<u>Video entries:</u> Again, the actual video entries are not due until **April 17, 2020**, but we do need the Final Application Form returned to us by **January 17, 2020** indicating your school will be submitting entries. This allows us to schedule critique times for you prior to the program going to the printer in March. <u>Please do not list your school if the video entry will not be ready in the seven months from school opening until the deadline date.</u>

All entries beyond those which are listed above are \$20 per STUDENT or ITEM. For example, an additional choral group of 12 students performing in large vocal music would be an additional \$240. Over 10 submissions in creative writing, the cost would be \$20 per each additional entry. If you have extra art, either 2D or 3D, the fee is \$20 per piece. The above also depends upon space and time being available in order to accept the additional performance or critique entries. Purchase orders or checks for these additional entries must be received by Teen Arts by March 6, 2020 prior to the program being sent to the printer.

The application form is due on January 17, 2020.

The actual entries are due to be submitted no later than **April 10, 2020.**

Entries will be submitted online by emailing them to BCTACW or mailing them to our offices.

Your registration fee entitles you to submit 10 entries

- 1. Each entry should be a maximum of four (4) letter size pages in length. Please use a font no smaller than 12 point. Margins should be 1" on all four sides.
- 2. Please identify each work with the student name and school in the title of the file.
- 3. Please identify each work with the full name of the student, age, grade, and school at the beginning of the file.
- **4.** Teachers are encouraged to submit examples of imaginative student writing rather than expository essays.
- 5. Students may submit as many selections in any genre as will fit in 4 pages. Indicate the genre on the Critique Form.
- 6. Original works are accepted in poetry, short story, flash fiction, drama or novel excerpts.
- 7. Please complete the Creative Writing Summary Form that is included in this packet and submit it along with the student entries.
- 8. A Critique sheet is included in this packet so that you can show students what elements are used in the critique. However, NEW THIS YEAR, you do not have to complete Critique sheets for each student. That will be done by the Teen Arts office.
- 9. Share entries to BCTACW@gmail.com from your Google Drive or email them as attachments to the same address. Please include your Summary Form and one Creative Writing Critique Form for each student entry. Alternately, entries may be mailed to our offices.
- 10. All written critiques will be returned to the students after their scheduled meeting with the critiquer at the festival. If students do not attend the critique session their critiques will be returned to the school liaisons.
- 11. Schools that submit less than 10 entries may be scheduled for a shorter critique session to permit all students the most effective critique.
- 12. One of the most positive aspects of the festival is its ability to have professional artists and educators critique work and give an unbiased, honest, evaluation of their entries. With that in mind, these same students should be encouraged to attend not only the critique session for their school, but should be confident enough to attend the open microphone, "The Poet's Voice" workshop and read their entry to their peers.

Additional entries over those included in your school Registration Fee will be accepted as our schedule permits. The fee for additional entries is \$20 each.

DANCE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS 2020 Bergen County Teen Arts Festival

The final application form is due on **January 17, 2020.** You are permitted one entry in both small and large group dance.

Small Group Dance is for **7 (change in number for this year)** or fewer students. Each entry is permitted 10 min. It is suggested that your performance take no more than 5 min. to allow for the students to receive comments from the professionals who will be critiquing their performance.

Large Group Dance is for more than 7 students (**change in number for this year**). Again each entry is permitted 10 minutes but it is suggested that your performance take no more than 5 minutes to allow for the critique.

The Teen Arts Festival is an opportunity for the students to share and perform a finished piece of original, faculty, or student choreography in a studio or formal theater setting. Kindly consider the following guidelines when submitting a piece for the critique/review process. In an attempt to maintain the high standards of the festival, we are providing these guidelines to facilitate appropriate subject matter. All art is about choice and when students are preparing for the festival, careful consideration should be given to the following:

- 1. The Teen Arts Festival is NOT a competition. It is a learning experience to expand and enhance the knowledge of dance and performance. Critiques are offered to deepen the understanding of dance performance, to determine what works and doesn't work on stage, and to point the dancers, choreographers and advisory in new and challenging directions. All who participate are "winners."
- 2. Gymnastics, lip-syncing, baton twirling and cheerleading are NOT eligible. Dance expression, however, takes many forms. Some stylistic elements or aspects of other activities, if incorporated in a dance as an artistic statement, are acceptable. When in doubt, ask "Am I making an artistic statement and does it reflect a point of view?"
- 3. Arrange for a showing of the piece for other students or faculty members and seek input. Often their informal critiques can help assist dance groups and soloists for performances at the festival. Original choreography is encouraged. Please remember: *Your students are representing your school and your community*. Be prepared to show choreography for audiences who might be middle school students. Dances that are inappropriate in content, choreography or costuming will be asked to stop.
- 4. Appropriateness of music/sound should also be considered. Music without lyrics is preferred. If the music contains lyrics, please be aware of its content. Please refrain from explicit or disturbing lyrics. Instrumental music is preferred.

- 5. Costume/Make Up If working as a group, please try to show a unified look on the stage. Costuming may be simple, but appropriate. Refrain from cleavage-baring or otherwise revealing costumes. Good taste never goes out of style. School officials should monitor student presentations.
- 6. **BE PROMPT.** Please make sure dancers arrive with sufficient time to prepare to perform at their scheduled time. Schedules will be sent in April of 2020. No time or facility will be provided for rehearsal or run-through. <u>Students who are not ready at their scheduled time will only be allowed to perform at the end of the dance showcase, IF time allows.</u>
- 7. Musical Theater entries can be submitted in either Theater or Dance. The entry must conform to the time limit including set-up and break-down time. Be sure to mark your Final Application Form accordingly to indicate "Musical Theater."
- 8. Please be certain that the school's liaison has the correct information for all dances. Please return the Final Application Form to the Teen Arts office and keep a copy for your files.
- 9. Please have someone from your organization deliver your music media to the booth at the back of the Theater at least one group prior to your performance. Label it appropriately. If you are using an Ipod, a CD backup would be advised, if it is a CD, then a digital recording would provide your back-up.

The above guidelines are meant as a reference tool to assist you in your rehearsal and planning for the festival performance. We look forward to welcoming you and seeing you perform on May 15, 2020.

- 1. Time limits <u>include set-up</u>, <u>warm-up</u>, <u>performance</u>, <u>critique</u>, <u>and break-down time</u>. Time limits will be enforced. Performers that run over the time allowed will be asked to stop.
- 2. We ask our critique personnel to follow the time schedule as rigidly as possible. Groups or individuals that perform longer within the time limit allotted will receive less critique. For instance, a large group Concert band that takes 19 minutes to set-up, warm-up and perform will receive, at most, 1 minute of critique. **Please plan accordingly.**
- 3. Please register for the appropriate site. Large groups are over 10 students and Small Groups are 10 students or less. Groups that do not conform to the appropriate participant limit will be asked to perform with appropriately populated groups or THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE WITHOUT PERFORMING. Ignoring these limits has created difficult situations in the past for both the critique personnel and performers.
- 4. Piano Performance –Piano performance will be a separate category and each entering school will receive one 15 minute time slot per application fee. Two pianists per slot are acceptable but will decrease the critique time for each. The time schedule will be strictly adhered to. PLEASE NOTE Piano Performance will be on a recently tuned upright Piano in a classroom. No other venue or instrument is available.
- 5. For vocal music, we strongly prefer live accompaniment. You may bring an accompanist to play with your group. If you must use a recorded accompaniment, it is your responsibility to supply a sound system for playback. A music stand will be provided for the conductor of a large group vocal music performance.
- 6. Please supply the critiquer with copies of music prior to your performance.

- 7. Four Timpani, one xylophone, one bass drum and approximately 70 music stands will be provided in the gym for large instrumental performances. A standard drum set, a guitar amp and a bass amp will be provided in the student center for jazz group performances. This year we will also provide a "standard" keyboard and amp. Equipment details will be available in the spring If you require other instruments for your performance, you must bring them yourselves.
- 8. All students should be present at least two groups before your scheduled performance. <u>If your group is not ready to perform when scheduled, the next group will be called and, if necessary, your performance will be placed at the end of the schedule.</u>
- 9. We will provide three large instrumental group sites one for Concert Bands, one for Orchestras and small group string groups and one for Jazz/Rock groups. Please indicate on your application form the type of group that you will be bringing to the festival. This does not increase the number of Large Instrumental Music Groups that you can bring to the festival with your base registration fee. It remains one either Concert Band, Orchestra or Jazz/Rock Group.

The Teen Arts Festival Advisory Board and Art Planning Committee are requesting that any junior or senior high school participating in the Annual Teen Arts Festival, if they wish, submit entries to be considered for use as the cover for the following year's Bergen County Teen Arts Festival program. There will be a limit of 10 submissions per school.

The cover of the 2020 program will be chosen by the Art Planning Committee from the entries submitted. Other entries will be used, as space permits, within the program. There is no guarantee on how many submissions per school will be used as program art as has been the case for the past two years. All artists whose work is used will be recognized in the program.

The requirements which must be strictly followed are as follows:

- 1. All entries must be brought to the 2020 Teen Arts Festival on the Thursday prior to the festival (May 14, 2020) when you come to hang your art.
- 2. Entries must be on card stock type material and be approximately 8.5 inches high by 11 inches wide. Entries that do not conform to these measurements may be resized appropriately to fit the requirements of the cover and the program.
- 3. Entries must be black and white. For example, they can be pen & ink or black cut paper placed on white paper, or white cut paper on black paper.
- 4. Entries created digitally will be accepted but they must be black and white and suitable for offset printing appropriate to our "non-color" cover.
- 5. Entries should depict all the various artistic genres represented at the festival; art; creative writing; dance; film & video; instrumental music; vocal music, and theater.
- 6. The artists name, grade, address, home phone number and school must be printed on the back of the submitted piece of art.
- 7. Entries must be from students in grades 7 through 11 ONLY! No senior entries will be considered as they will have already graduated prior to the festival program being printed and issued at the festival.
